RESOLUTION NO. 3233

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON. AUTHORIZING JUDGE JOANNA J. DANIELS TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH CONSEJO COUNSELING AND REFERRAL SERVICES AND THE BONNEY LAKE MUNICIPAL COURT AND COMMUNITY COURT FROM JULY 1, 2024, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2024, AT NO COST TO THE COMMUNITY COURT.

WHEREAS The Bonney Lake Municipal Community Court, hereafter referred to as Community Court, was awarded continued funding through the Administrative Office of the Courts Therapeutic Court Program under Contract #1AA25060 and;

WHEREAS The Bonney Lake Municipal Court Motions to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding, hereafter referred to as MOU, with Consejo Counseling and Referral Services, hereafter referred to as Consejo, and the Bonney Lake Municipal Court and Community Court. Consejo is not requiring commitment of any funds to support this Memorandum. Consejo shall provide Substance Use Evaluation and Treatment, Mental Health Evaluation and Treatment, Peer Support with weekly status reports including case notes and referrals to appropriate agencies and compliance with sobriety, all at no cost to Community Court. Additionally, Consejo shall make its services available to anyone in the Bonney Lake Municipal Court who has a need for services they offer; in other words, individuals who are defendants accused of committing a crime in Bonney Lake as well as participants in the Community Court. Consejo shall fund its own activities and services. The Bonney Lake Municipal Court and its Community Court shall permit Consejo to use the Municipal Justice Center's Kiosk vestibule on Mondays and Wednesdays to meet with participants and defendants. The MOU shall be effective July 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, WASHINGTON DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Joanna J. Daniels, Bonney Lake Municipal Court Judge, is authorized to sign the proposed MOU with Consejo for a period of six months effective July 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024.

Consejo Counseling And Referral Services Is Not Requiring Commitment Of Funds Between Consejo And The Community Court. Consejo Shall Provide Weekly Status Reports, Peer Support, Case Notes, Referrals To Agencies And Compliance With Sobriety To Community Court Participants And Evaluations And Follow Up Treatment To Defendants In The Bonney Lake Municipal Court System, At No Cost To The City Of Bonney Lake. Consejo Will Fund Its Own Activities And Services. The Bonney Lake Municipal Court Shall Permit Consejo To Use The Municipal Court Justice Center's Kiosk Vestibule On Mondays And Wednesdays To Meet With Participants And Interested Defendants.

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Bonney Lake Community Court

and

Consejo Counseling and Referral Services

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and understanding between the Bonney Lake Community Court hereafter referred to as Court and Consejo Counseling and Referral Services hereafter referred to as Consejo to provide the services identified in this document to Participants in the Bonney Lake Community Court Program.

Background

The Court operates with a grant that is funded by the Administration Office of the Courts, thereafter, referred to as AOC and makes available, through a collaborative effort between the courts, public entities and service providers necessary resources to participants including, but not limited to Substance Use Evaluation and Treatment and Mental Health Evaluations and Treatment, clothing, housing, social services, behavioral health treatment and peer support services.

Purpose

This MOU sets forth expectations, responsibilities, and agreements between the Court and Consejo.

The Court shall provide designated space at the Municipal Justice Center for use by Consejo when meeting with and providing specified services to the public, Court and Participants.

Reporting

Consejo shall provide weekly client status reports, including case notes and referrals to agencies and compliance with sobriety. This report shall be provided to the Community Court Case Manager by 4:00 pm on Thursday of each week.

Funding and Use

This Agreement is not a commitment of funds between the Court and Consejo. The Court permits Consejo to use the Municipal Justice Centers Kiosk Vestibule on the 1st Floor from 8:30

am to 4:30 pm Monday and Wednesday, at no cost to make its services available to citizens through the Court. Consejo will fund its own activities and services, including providing supplies and any needed equipment. Consejo will exercise reasonable and ordinary care in its use of the facilities, will use them only for the purpose(s) herein identified, and will be solely responsible for its own services, employees, and the conduct of its employees and agents.

Indemnification and Defense

In executing this Agreement, the parties do not assume liability or responsibility for or in any way release the other from any liability or responsibility which arises in whole or in part from the existence or affect of each parties' legal duties or responsibilities. Each party agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the other party from any and all third-party claims, demands, costs, liabilities, losses, expenses, and damages resulting from its employee's, officer's or agent's actions, errors or omissions.

Duration

Beginning 07/01/2024 and ending 12/31/2024 the facilities are made available for Consejo at the will of the Court and such permission may be revoked at any time. This Agreement may be modified by mutual consent of authorized officials from the Court and Consejo. This MOU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials from the Court and Consejo and will remain in effect until modified or terminated by any one of the parties or by mutual consent. In the event this arrangement is terminated, the parties agree to work cooperatively to transition any programs or services as needed.
