

RESOLUTION NO. 2817

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, APPROVING THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE GENERAL SEWER SYSTEM PLAN AND EXPRESSING INTENT TO AMEND THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES AND SERVICES ELEMENT AS PART OF 2020 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE.

WHEREAS, the current City of Bonney Lake General Sewer System Plan (Sewer System Plan) was approved by Council in 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution 2495 on November 10, 2015 with RH-2, to complete the effort for updating the Sewer System Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bonney Lake acts as the sewer purveyor for the Bonney Lake Sewer Service areas which includes areas within the incorporated limits of the City of Bonney Lake and areas within unincorporated Pierce County; and


WHEREAS, the City has received and responded to the comments from the Department of Ecology to complete the 2019 update to the Sewer System Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, WASHINGTON DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of Bonney Lake approves the 2019 update the Sewer System Plan, attached as Exhibit A, covering the entire Bonney Lake sewer service area.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City staff is directed to prepare the an amendment to Community Facilities and Services Element of Bonney Lake 2035 to officially adopt the 2019 Sewer System Plan as part of the City's comprehensive plan as part of the 2020 Comprehensive Plan Amendments.



Agenda Subject: 2019 Sewer System Plan Update

Full Title/Motion: A Resolution of the City of Bonney Lake, Washington, approving the City of Bonney Lake General Sewer System Plan and expressing intent to amend the Community Facilities and Services Element as part of 2020 comprehensive plan update.

Administrative Recommendation: Approve

Background Summary: The current City of Bonney Lake General Sewer System Plan (SSP) was approved in 2009 covering the entire Bonney Lake service area, which includes areas within the incorporated limits of the City of Bonney Lake and areas within unincorporated Pierce County. On November 10, 2015, the Council passed Resolution 2495 authorizing RH2 to update the SSP. Finalizing the SSP was delayed in order to address comments received by the Department of Ecology (DOE) and finalize rates to support the SSP's budget requirements. The plan has been completed and is available for review in electronic form at the following link: [2019 SSP](#). Once the City Council approves the updated SSP for the entire service area, an amendment to the City's Community Facilities and Services Element of the comprehensive plan will also be needed to add the 2019 SSP to the overall facility plan for the City.
