

RESOLUTION NO. 368

WHEREAS, Section 4, Chapter 172, laws of 1982, Revised Code of Washington 70.136.030 as amended requires that the governing body of the Town of Quincy designate a hazardous materials incident command agency within the boundaries of the Town of Quincy; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Quincy has considered the training, manpower, expertise, and equipment of available agencies and the applicable codes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Quincy finds that Grant County Fire Protection District No. 3 is available to respond to hazardous materials incident within the Town of Quincy.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Quincy that Grant County Fire Protection District No. 3 is hereby designated as a hazardous materials incident command agency to operate within the boundaries of the Town of Quincy.
