**Councilmember McClimans motioned to strike out “other than cannabis” from section 9.13.04. Councilmember Davis seconded the motion.**


**Motion to amend section 9.13.04 approved 7-0.**


**Ordinance D25-24 approved as amended 7 – 0.**
