A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF 3 SETS OF NIGHT VISION DEVICES, RELATED SIGHTING SYSTEMS, AND MOUNTS IN SUPPORT OF BLPD SWAT TEAM MEMBERS ASSIGNED TO METRO SWAT.

WHEREAS, The Bonney Lake Police Department has 3 police officers assigned as tactical members with METRO SWAT; and


WHEREAS, METRO SWAT has identified night vision equipment as an important tool supporting SWAT tactics in narcotics investigations and apprehension; and

WHEREAS, the current police department 121 fund budget will support this purchase;



Full Title/Motion: A Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Bonney Lake, Pierce County, Washington, To Authorize The Purchase Of 3 Sets Of Night Vision Devices, Related Sighting Systems, And Mounts In Support Of BLPD SWAT Team Members Assigned To METRO SWAT.

Administrative Recommendation: Approve.

Background Summary: BLPD Participates In The Regional METRO SWAT Team. 121 Fund Justification: The Vast Majority Of METRO SWAT Operations Are Search Warrants For Narcotics Stemming From Narcotics Investigations. These Include Joint Law Enforcement Operations Where Costs Are Incurred By BLPD And METRO SWAT While Participating In Joint Law Enforcement Operations With Federal Agencies, Including The DEA. Based On The Changing Tactics Of Those Involved In The Distribution And Manufacturing Of Narcotics Combined With Increased Access To Technologies Providing Counter Surveillance And Early Warning Of Law Enforcement, SWAT Teams Have Changed Their Tactics To Include Nighttime And Early Morning Surveillance, Approaches, And Apprehensions. The Purchase Of These Items Will Assist In The Location, Identification, Apprehension And Investigation Of Narcotics Distribution And Manufacturing.
