

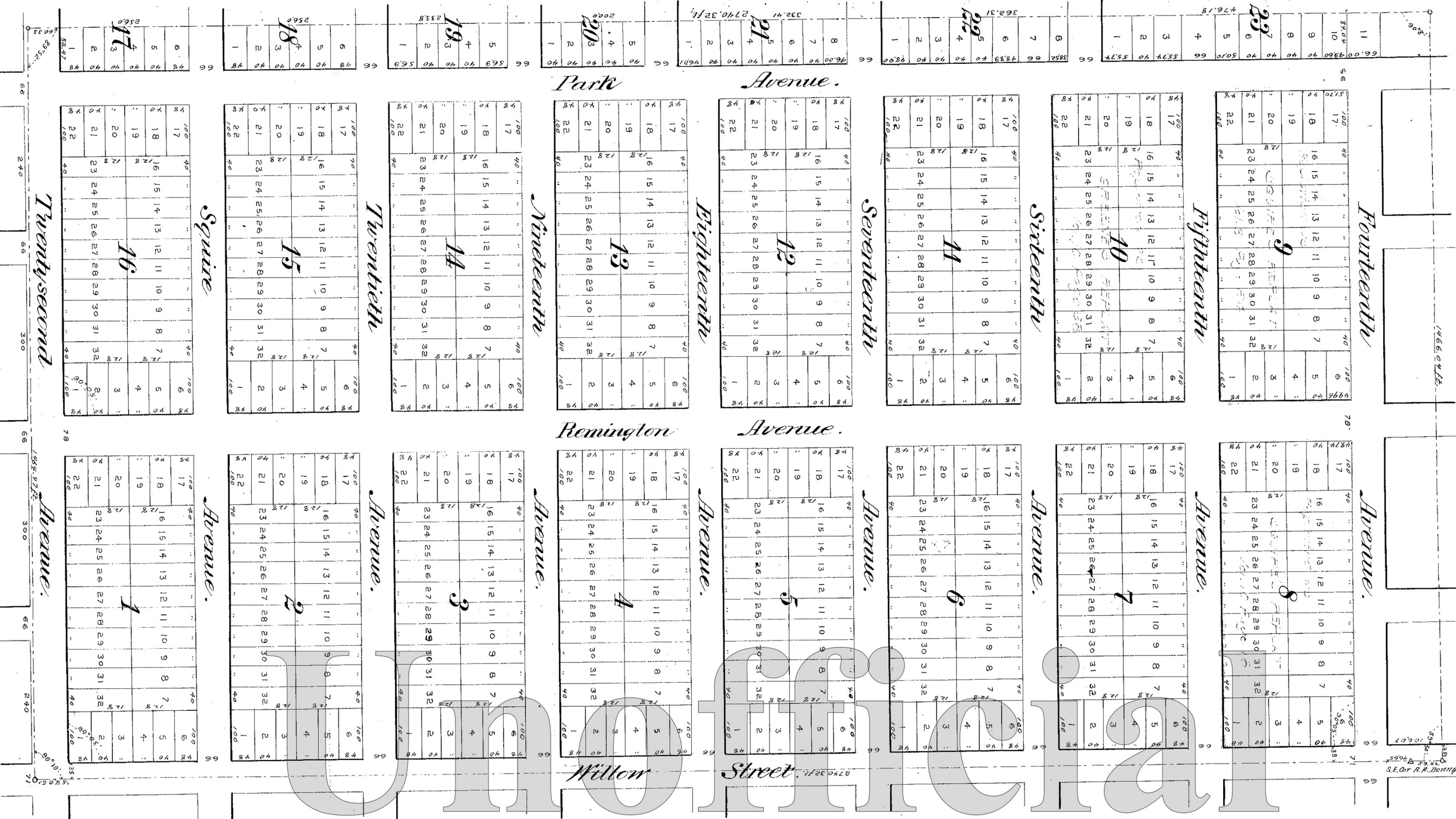

Description.

This Plat of Squire Park (Addition to the City of Seattle, King Co. Washington) is embraced within the following described boundaries: Beginning at a point 47.15 feet North of the S.E. Corner of the C. H. Boren Donation Plats, running thence West a distance of 2740.32 feet, thence North a distance of 1466.04 feet, thence East a distance of 2740.32 feet, thence South a distance of 1464.47 feet to the point of beginning. The initial point of this plat is the S.E. Corner of this tract. The widths of Streets and Avenues are as shown on this plat.

Dedication.

Then all men by these Presents, that we W. C. Squire and Ida H. Squire, his wife, and each of us, owners in fee simple of the above described plat of the Squire Park (Addition to the City of Seattle, King Co.
