ORDINANCE NO. 1733

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, VACATING AN EXISTING SEWER EASEMENT LOCATED ON THE EAST PIERCE FIRE & RESCUE STATION 111 PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, PUBLICATION, AND CORRECTIONS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Joel Ingraham granted the City of Bonney Lake a sewer utility easement (recording number 201204170149) on April 10, 2012, located within parcel number 5640001192; and

WHEREAS, during the construction process of East Pierce Fire & Rescue Station 111 a portion of said easement was relocated for the purpose of re-installing sewer main outside of the proposed building foundation area; and

WHEREAS, a right-of-way vacation application, to release the original sewer easement was submitted to the City of Bonney Lake on November 27, 2024; and

WHEREAS, to release the previous existing easement, the City Council must hold a public hearing to determine whether the easement vacation is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, BLMC 12.40.010.E mandates that the public hearing date for an easement vacation be established by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 3267 on March 11, 2025, setting the public hearing on April 8, 2025; and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing was provided in accordance with the requirements of BLMC 12.40.040; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the City Council on April 8, 2025; and

WHEREAS, no information or testimony was offered or presented regarding the proposed easement vacation at the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that it is in the public interest to vacate the existing East Pierce Fire & Rescue Station 111 sewer easement described in Exhibit A and illustrated in Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, the Council on the basis of evidence received at the public hearing including staffs recommendation, has concluded that vacation and relocation of the previous existing easement will not adversely affect any public interest; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Vacation. The easement as described in Exhibit A and illustrated in Exhibit B, dedicated to the City of Bonney Lake for utility purposes situated IS HEREBY VACATED.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Severability</u>. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 3. <u>Publication</u>. This Ordinance shall be published by an approved summary consisting of the title.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Corrections</u>. Upon the approval of the city attorney, the city clerk, and/or the code publisher is authorized to make any necessary technical corrections to this ordinance, including but not limited to the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any reference thereto. Provided, however, that nothing in this section allows the city attorney, the city clerk, and/or the code publisher to change the intent of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5 days after adoption and publication as provided by law.

EXHIBIT "A" EASEMENT DESCRIPTION

A portion of Parcels "A", "B", and "C" of City of Bonney Lake Boundary Line Adjustment PLN-2009-01159, recorded under Auditors File Number 200903135004, contained within a 15.00 foot wide strip of land, lying 7.50 feet on either side of the following described centerline:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Parcel "B", said point also lying on the North right of way line of Sumner Buckley Highway East; thence on the South line of said Parcel "B", being coincident with said right of way, 138.83 feet on the arc of a 340.00 foot radius curve to the left, whose central angle is 23°23'41", and chord bears North 65°12'13" East, 137.86 feet to the **True Point of Beginning**; thence leaving said South line North 00°31'22" West, 6.20 feet to a point; thence North 37°55'12" West, 87.96 feet to a point; thence North 52°04'48" East, 84.28 feet to a point; thence North 33°52'02" West, 110.02 feet to a point; thence North 01°16'33" West, 248.74 feet to a point; thence North 35°12'37" East, 16.78 to a point on the South right of way line of Main Street East and the terminus point of this centerline. All lying in the Southwest ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of Section 33, Township 20 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, Pierce County, Washington, and containing 8,307 square feet, more or less.

Side lines of said easement shall extend or terminate on the appropriate intersection with property lines or right of ways.




