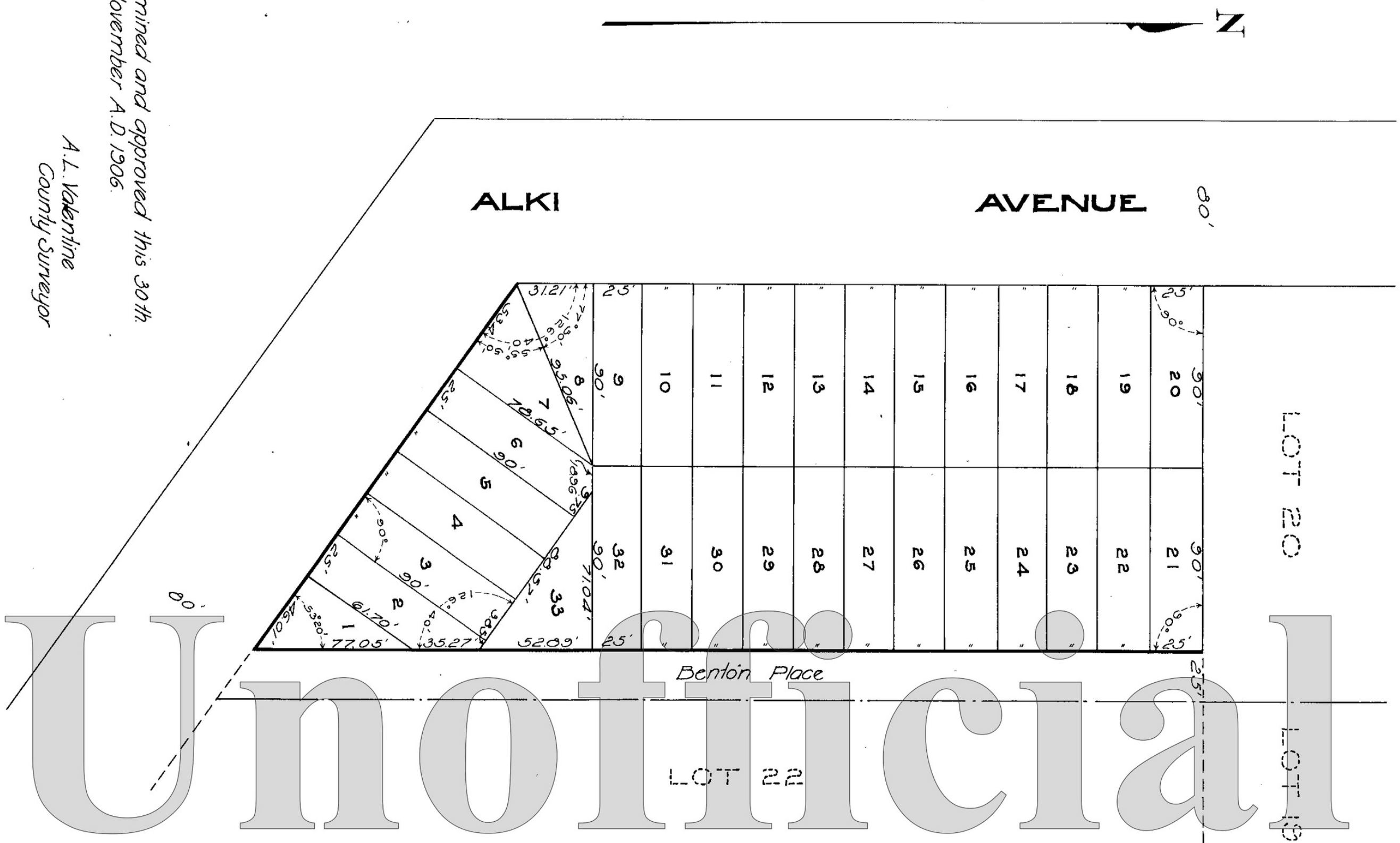


"Shore Acres"
