

RESOLUTION NO. 2855

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DECLARE A PUBLIC WORKS EMERGENCY AND WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS TO FACILITATE REPAIR OF THE LIFT STATION 17 WET WELL.

WHEREAS, On July 2, 2020, Sewer Utility staff observed wastewater beginning to seep through seams in the poured concrete wall dividing the wet and dry sides of the lift station and that the areas impacted by the leak appeared to be spreading;

WHEREAS, Lift Station 17 was constructed in 1987 and is the largest lift station in the Bonney Lake sewer conveyance system delivering approximately 90 percent of the wastewater generated in the City of Bonney Lake to the Sumner Wastewater Treatment Plant;

WHEREAS, Given the critical nature of this piece of infrastructure and the need for it to remain in service continuously and that a leak of any kind can lead to potentially catastrophic impacts to the sewer utility system and the surrounding community, businesses and environment;

WHEREAS, per RCW 39.04.280, competitive bidding requirements may be waived in the event of a Public Works emergency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Bonney Lake City Council does hereby authorize the Mayor to declare a Public Works emergency, waive competitive bidding requirements, and permit the procurement of contractor services to conduct the needed repair at Lift Station 17.

Full Title/Motion: A Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Bonney Lake, Pierce County, Washington, Authorizing The Mayor To Declare, Per Rcw 39.04.280, A Public Works Emergency And Waive Competitive Bidding Requirements To Procure Contractor Services To Repair Lift Station 17.

Administrative Recommendation: Approve

Background Summary: On July 2, 2020, Sewer Utility staff observed wastewater beginning to seep through seams in the poured concrete wall dividing the wet and dry sides of the lift station and that the areas impacted by the leak appeared to be spreading. Given the critical nature of this piece of infrastructure and the need for it to remain in service continuously and that a leak of any kind can lead to potentially catastrophic impacts to the sewer utility system and the surrounding community, businesses and environment contractor services were required to repair the leaking areas in the concrete to prevent the leaks from spreading or becoming worse. Staff contacted a vendor to perform this service and received a quote. Work was initiated to repair the leaks on July 20, 2020.
