

AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SEATTLE.

DESCRIPTION

This Plat of "Carleton Park, An Addition to the City of Seattle, Washington," includes and covers the following described tracts, all being in Section Twenty-two (22) of Township Twenty-five (25), Range Three (3) East of the Willamette Meridian, in King County, State of Washington, to wit:

That portion of "Ladd's Addition to the City of Seattle" (hereinafter platted and recorded on Page 59 of Volume 2 of plats in the Records of King County) which was designated as Blocks One (1) to Thirty-two (32) inclusive, of said Plat, together with all the streets, avenues and alleys between and bordering said blocks, except Sherman Avenue, now Magnolia Parkway, along the southwesterly side thereof; which said blocks, streets, avenues and alleys (with such exceptions as are expressed in the vacation ordinance and clearly designated upon the face of this Plat) have been duly vacated by the City of Seattle by Ordinances No. 30458 and No. 34779.

2. All of the "Supplemental Plat to Ladd's Addition" (hereinafter platted and recorded on page 67 of Volume 2 of Plats in the Records of King County) including all the blocks, lots, streets, avenues and alleys within said Plat, as the same have been duly vacated by the City of Seattle by Ordinance No. 34779.

3. All of "Wright's Addition to the City of Seattle" (hereinafter platted and recorded on page 181 of Volume 1 of Plots in the Records of King County), including all the blocks, lots, streets, avenues and alleys within said Plat, as the same (with such exceptions as are expressed in the vacation ordinance and clearly designated upon the face of this Plat) have been duly vacated by the City of Seattle by Ordinance No. 34779.

4. That portion of the South Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (S. 1/2 of N.E. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4) of said Section Twenty-two (22), lying west of the west margin of Thirty-second Avenue West as defined and established by the City of Seattle by Ordinance No. 32897 for the extension of Thirty-fourth Avenue West and other streets; also the south of 37. 2^o of said subdivision lying east of said west margin of 32nd Ave. W.

Also that portion of Government Lot Four (4) of said Section Twenty-two (22), lying north of the Magnolia Parkway tract or strip heretofore conveyed to the City of Seattle for park and back-yard purposes, crossing said Lot Four (4) by a westerly,

southerly and northwesterly course or courses.

Also such portions of the last described two tracts as have heretofore been conveyed for street purposes (West Home Street), which has been duly vacated by the City of Seattle by Ordinance No. 34779.

5. That portion of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (N.E. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4) of said Section Twenty-two (22) lying west of the west margin of Thirty-second Avenue West, and south of the south margin of West McGraw Street, as the same have been defined and established by the City of Seattle by Ordinance No. 32897 for the extension of Thirty-fourth Avenue West and other streets.

6. That portion of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (S.E. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4) of said Section Twenty-two (22) lying west of the west margin of Thirty-fourth Avenue West, as defined and established by the City of Seattle by Ordinance No. 32897 for the extension of Thirty-fourth Avenue West and other streets.

7. That portion of the South Half of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (S. 1/2 of N.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4) of said Section Twenty-two (22), lying north of the north boundary of the "Supplemental Plat to Ladd's Addition," as recorded on page 67 of Volume 2 of Plats in the Records of King County.

Excepting from description (1) above noted, the following lots in Ladd's Addition and their added portions of adjacent vacated streets and alleys, as indicated on this Plat, to wit: - Lots 1 and 2, of Block 4, Ladd's Add'n, which are identical with Lots 5 and 2, Block 6 of this Plat. Lots 3 and 6, of Block 11, Ladd's Add'n, which are, respectively, identical with Lots 5 and 2, Block 6 of this Plat.

The location and dimensions of all blocks, lots, avenues, streets, drives, backyards, parks, paths, courts, places, circles, lanes and alleys are as indicated upon the face of the Plat. Where no dimensions are indicated for small park tracts shown by dotted lines within the limits of street or street intersections, it is intended that the precise park area shall be determined by the City Authorities in each case at the time of the improvement of the street or intersection surrounding or bordering any such park area, as may be consistent with the relative requirements for street and park purposes, and subject to modification thereafter as the City Authorities, on the same basis of relative requirements, may determine.

The location of the section and subdivision lines of said Section Twenty-two (22), within which this Plat is contained, and of the various monuments fixed by the City of Seattle in perpetuation of the government corners and establishment of various subdivision corners, together with the courses and distances determining the relation of the various block and street lines throughout this Plat to said section and subdivision lines and corners, are as indicated upon the face of this Plat. All bearings are referred to the *Seattle Tide Lands Meridian*, which Meridian is N. 0° 07' 06" W. of the City Standard Meridian.

BUILDING LINES AND RESTRICTIONS

Nothing but a single, detached residence shall be built on any one lot within this Plat, and when built shall be used for residence purposes only. This restriction shall not apply to lots fronting upon West McGraw Street between Thirty-second and Thirty-fifth Avenue West (including all lots in Block 53).

Every such single, detached residence shall cost not less than Five Thousand (\$5000) Dollars if fronting the Magnolia Parkway or Boulevard; not less than Three Thousand (\$3000) Dollars in those blocks of this Plat not fronting the Boulevard but having a westerly, southerly or southwesterly view of the Olympic Mountains and Puget Sound or of Elliott Bay, the central portion of the City and Mount Rainier; not less than Two Thousand (\$2000) Dollars in those blocks having a northeasterly, easterly or southeasterly view limited mainly to the Pleasant Valley and Wolf Creek vicinity; not less than Fifteen Hundred (\$1500) Dollars in those portions of the Plat between Thirty-fourth Avenue West and Thirty-second Avenue West and also within the tract described in the 6th paragraph of the above "Description" north of a line 100 feet north of West McGraw Street.

No structure, including any porch thereon, shall be set nearer than twenty-five (25) feet to the marginal line of the street upon which the structure faces. This restriction may be modified in case of any special lot of irregular shape, provided that in such cases there shall be a substantial compliance in harmony with adjacent lots.

Any garage or other necessary appurtenance of a residence shall either be constructed as a part thereof, or if isolated, shall be

of architectural design in harmony with the residence.



DEDICATION

I know all men by these presents, that R.V. Ankney, as trustee, R.V. Ankney and Nellie P. Ankney, his wife, Mrs. Josephine S. Atwood, Dexter Horton Trust and Savings Bank, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Washington, Samuel Kaufman and Sarah S. Packer, as executors and trustees of the Estate of David Kaufman, deceased, owners in fee simple of the tracts described in the accompanying instrument entitled "Description" and William Anna Loring as mortgagee have this day platted the same as Carlton Park, an addition to the City of Seattle, Washington, and do hereby declare said Plat and dedicate to the use of the public forever all the avenues, streets, drives, boulevards, parks, parkways, courts, places, circles, lanes and alleys shown thereon, and the use thereof for any and all public purposes, not inconsistent with the use thereof, or for public highway purposes; also the right to make all necessary slopes for cuts or fills upon any lot, in the reasonable original grading of any street or alley shown herein, provided, however, that the various tracts indicated as parks, including that designated as Carlton Center, shall be construed as an express dedication for public parks or parkways and the same shall be maintained thereafter for such purposes. And the said owners do further fix and establish the Building Lines and Restrictions set forth in the accompanying statement thereto.

In witness whereof, the said persons, trustees and executors and the said corporation, hereinbefore designated as the owners of the property included in this plat, and making the dedications and dedications hereinbefore set forth, have hereunto respectively set their hands and seals and the said corporation has caused these presents to be executed by its Vice-President and Secretary and has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed.


