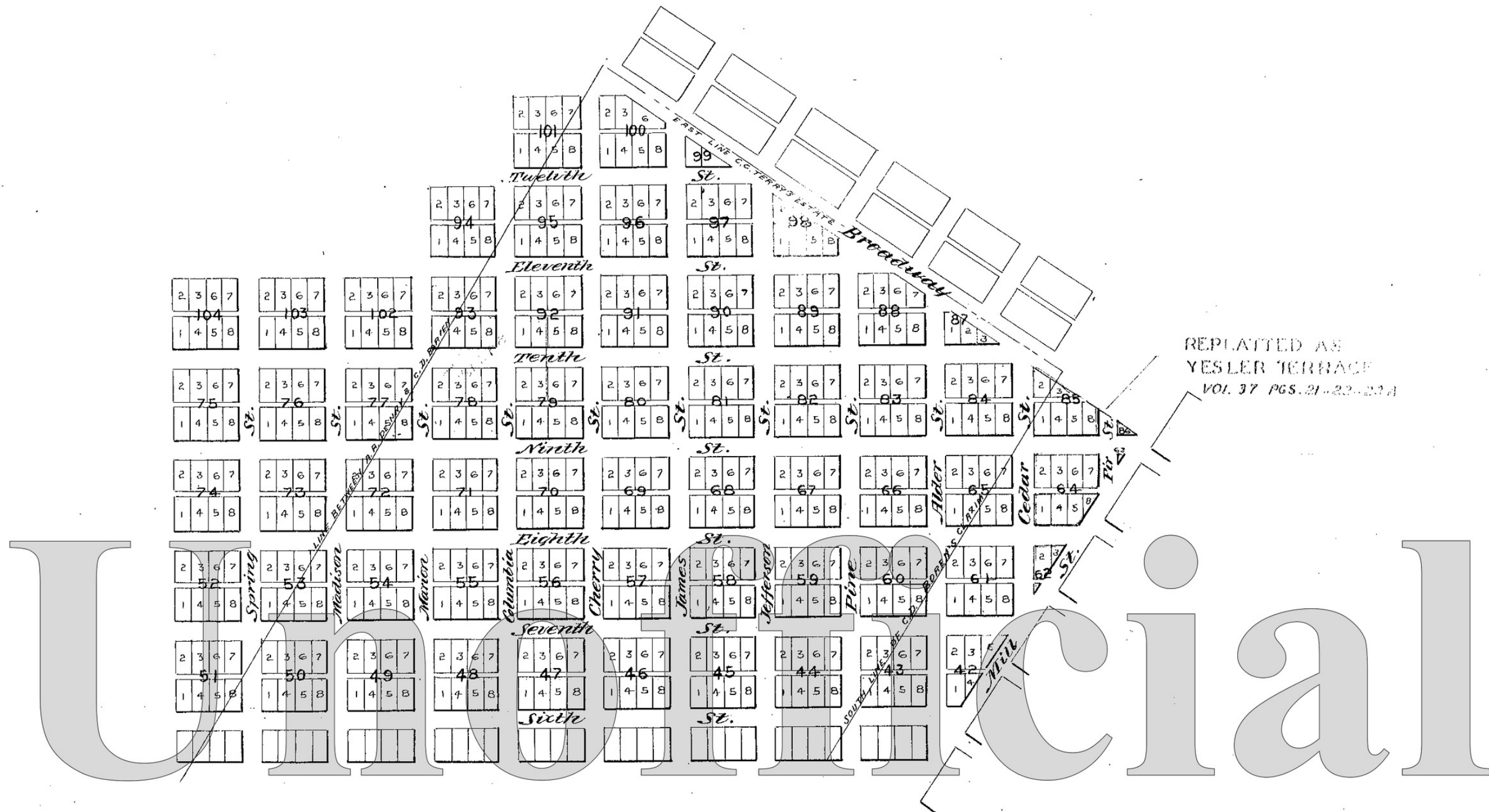


Terry's Second Addition

TO THE TOWN OF SEATTLE.



Being on the West half of C. D. Borer's Donation Claim including also Fractional parts of A. A. Denny & H. L. Yesler's Donation Claims in Sec 5 of Town 24 N. R. 4 E. & Sec 32 of Town 25 N. R. 4 E.

Blocks from 6th to 9th Street previously recorded except the fractional blocks No 42, 43, 51, 53, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65 & 72, belonging to H. L. Yesler and A. A. Denny, since the making of this plat, Blocks No 52, 73, 74, 75 & 76 have been placed on Record by A. A. Denny as an extension of the First Addition, Broadway 80 ft. wide, other Streets 66 ft. wide Alleys 16 ft. Lots not fractional 60 by 120 ft. Streets run N 32° W and 58° E, excepting Mill Street and Broadway, Magnetic Variation 21° 45' East.
