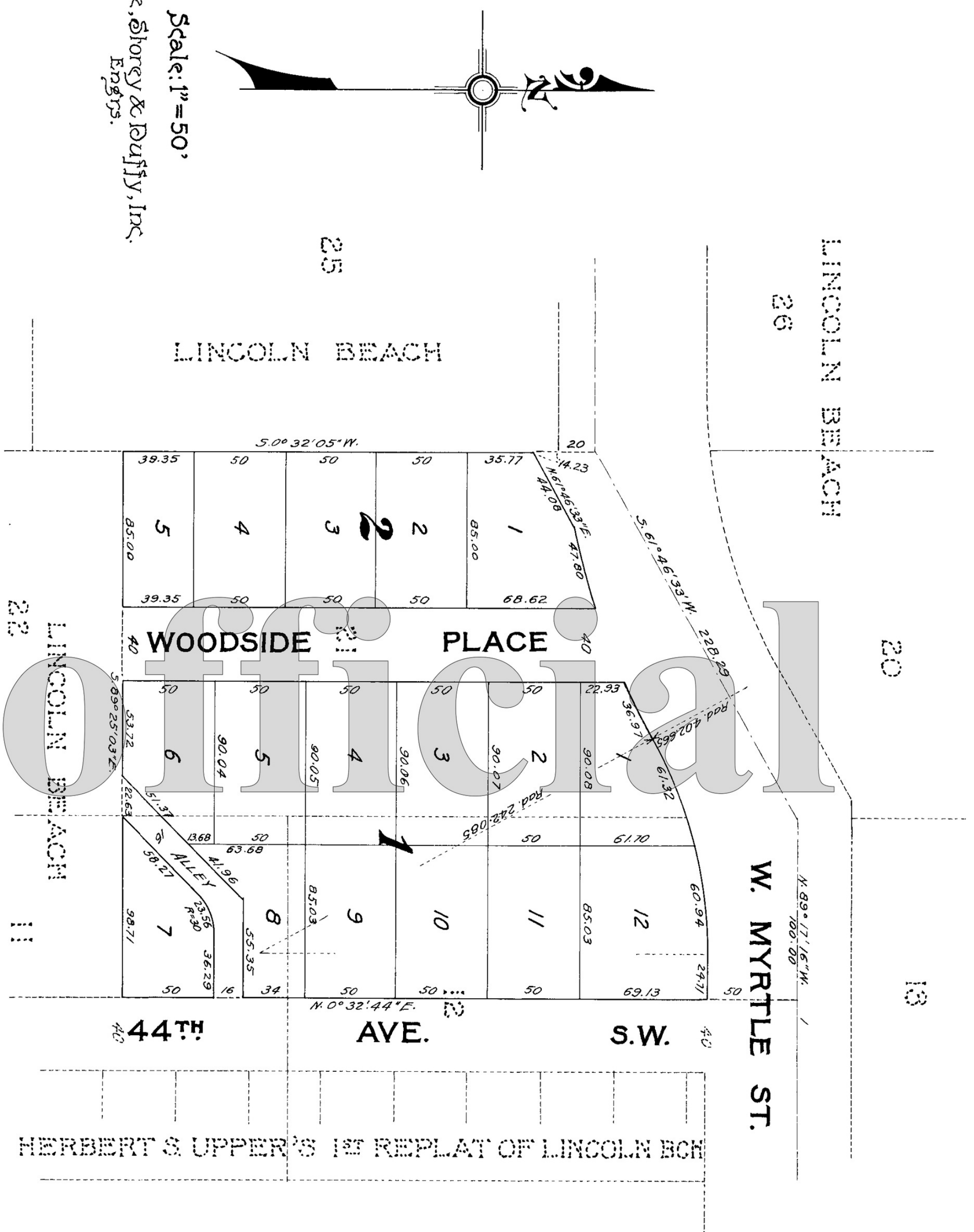


WOODSIDIE

AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SEATTLE

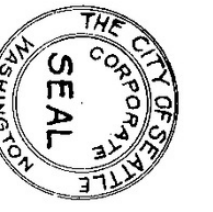

DESCRIPTION

This plat of Woodside, an Addition to the City of Seattle, comprises all of Tract Twenty-one (21) and the west half of Tract Twelve (12), excepting the portion of said Tracts appropriated for West Myrtle Street and all that part of the west half of Tract Eleven (11) lying north of the south line of Tract Twenty-one (21) produced east to 44th Avenue South-west, or Lincoln Beach, King County, Wash., according to the plat on record in Volume 11 of Plats, Page 91, records of King County, Wash.

Approved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Seattle by Ordinance No. 39637 this 3rd day of July A. D. 1919.
