

ORDINANCE NO. 1738

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REGARDING RESTRICTED PARKING ON CITY STREETS AND IN CITY PARKING LOTS; AMENDING SECTIONS 10.36.015 10.36.020, AND 10.36.025 OF THE BONNEY LAKE MUNICIPAL CODE (BLMC) FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESTRICTING PARKING ON CITY STREETS AND IN CITY PARKING LOTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND CORRECTIONS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Allan Yorke Park is a heavily used City park and boat launch facility in Bonney Lake; and

WHEREAS, Allan Yorke Park is surrounded by residential development and roadways that are generally two-lanes wide; and

WHEREAS, often, particularly during summer months, the parking capacity of Allan Yorke Park is insufficient to meet the demand; and

WHEREAS, the proximity of Allan Yorke to the surrounding neighborhoods has resulted in parking overflow into the adjoining residential neighborhoods which has resulted in blocking driveways, intruding into travel lanes, and the creation of litter in the neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, in order to mitigate these impacts, the City Council deems it in the public interest to update the prohibited and restricted parking zones around Allan Yorke Park;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to reserve parking in the City-owned parking lots for employees and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the proximity of City-owned parking lots to surrounding neighborhoods has resulted in parking overflow, litter, overnight parking, and parking vehicles for sale in City-owned lots; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the public interest to restrict overnight parking in City-owned parking lots.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10.36.015 of the Bonney Lake Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.36.015 Prohibited parking zones.

Parking shall be prohibited:

...I. On the north side of 67th St. Ct. E. from West Tapps Hwy. E. and 195th Ave. E.

Section 2. Section 10.36.020 of the Bonney Lake Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.36.020 Restricted parking zones.

Parking without a city-issued permit is prohibited in the following zones:

... B. Allan Yorke Park.

... 10. On the south side of 67th St. Ct. E. from West Tapps Hwy. E. and 195th Ave. E.

Section 3. Section 10.36.025 of the Bonney Lake Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.36.025 Restricted parking in city parking lots.

A. City Parking Lots. Parking in the following parking lots owned by the City of Bonney Lake Justice and Municipal Center and Bonney Lake Library. Parking in the parking lot jointly serving the justice and municipal center (JMC) and Bonney Lake Library (library) shall be reserved for use by employees and visitors of the JMC and the library during business hours of each facility. Overnight parking shall be prohibited. Parking outside of or across an official line or mark designating a parking space shall be prohibited.;

1. Justice and Municipal Center and Bonney Lake Library shared parking lot.
2. Public Safety / Police Building.
3. Public Services Center.
4. Senior Center.
5. All other parking lots owned by the City not otherwise regulated by Chapter 12.12 BLMC.

Section 4. **Direction to Public Services Director.** The Public Services Director shall arrange for signs advising parking restrictions to be posted at visible locations.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.


Section 6. Publication. This Ordinance shall be published by an approved summary consisting of the title.

Section 7. Corrections. Upon the approval of the city attorney, the city clerk, and/or the code publisher is authorized to make any necessary technical corrections to this ordinance, including but not limited to the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any reference thereto. Provided, however, that nothing in this section allows the city attorney, the city clerk, and/or the code publisher to change the intent of this Ordinance.


Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective five days after publication as provided by law; provided that parking restrictions shall not be enforced until after the postage of signs in accordance with Section 4 of this Ordinance.

Administrative Recommendation: Approve

Short Background Summary (Use a memo to write a full history): The proposed amendment adds restricted and prohibited parking zones on 67th St Ct E between W Tapps Hwy E and 195th Ave E near Allan Yorke Park. Adjacent residents are being impacted by increased usage of Allan Yorke Park. In addition, the proposal adds overnight parking restrictions to more parking lots owned by the City that are not located in parks; specifically, the Public Safety/Police Building, the Public Services Center, and the Senior Center. The parking area near the Public Safety/Police Building will be striped and signed, allowing use of the parking stalls during normal business hours.
