

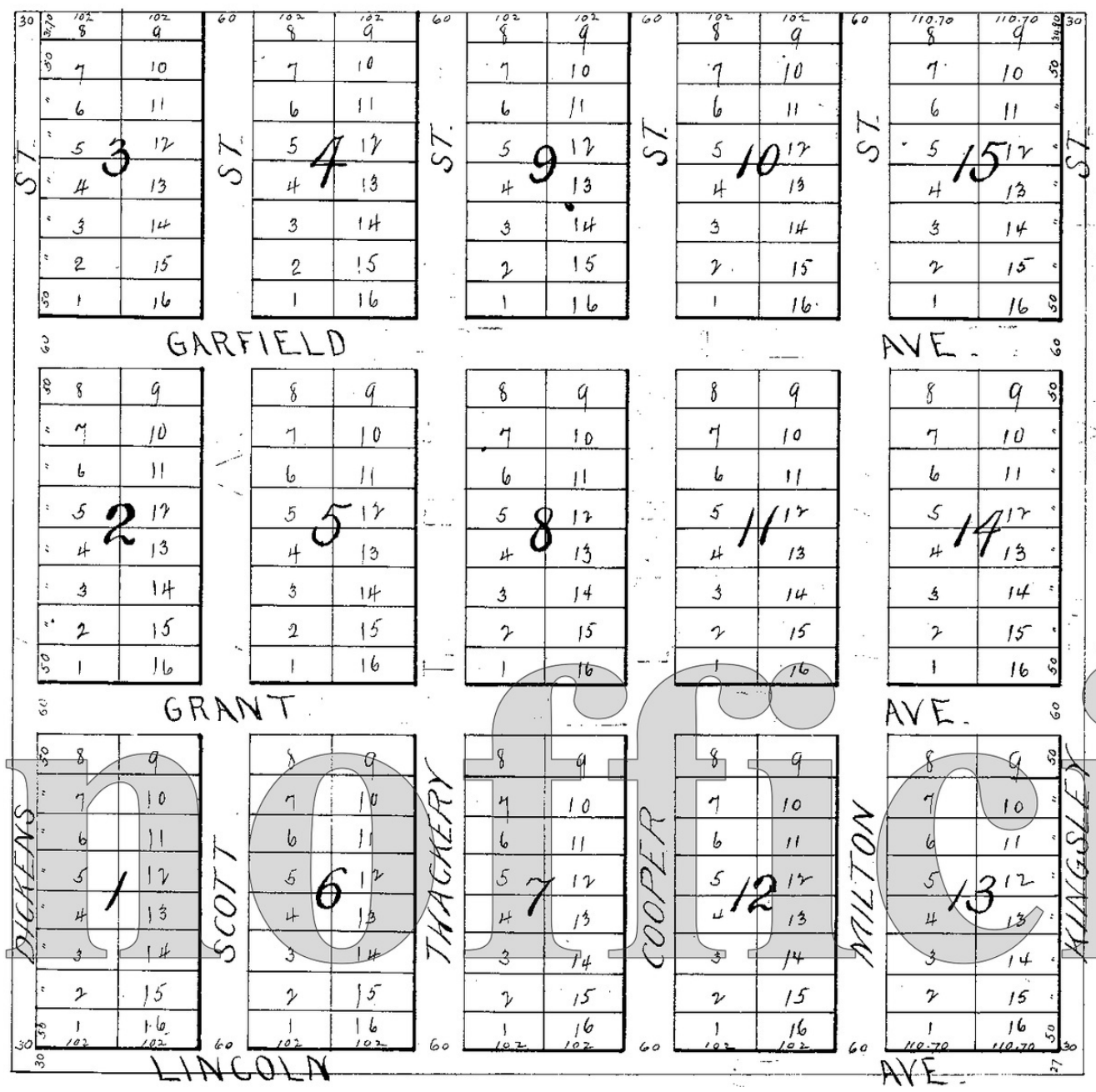
HARRISON HEIGHTS ADDITION

DESCRIPTION

This Harrison Heights Addition to the City of Seattle comprises the N.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 17 T. 25 N. R. 4 E. W. M. The initial point of this plat is the North East corner of Block 15, which is 30 feet West of the quarter section corner between Sections 8 and 17 T. 25 N. R. 4 E. W. M. All full regular lots are 50x102 feet except in Blocks 13, 14 and 15 which are 50x110.70 feet, irregular lots as noted on plat. Streets and Avenues are 60 feet wide except Dickens and Kingsley Sts, and Lincoln Ave. which are as noted on plat, North and South streets are parallel with North and South section lines. East and West streets at right angles. All measurements as noted on this plat are expressed in feet.
