**EXPLANATION.**

This Lake Union Addition to the City of Seattle occupies the East half of the North East quarter of Section 18, of T25, N of R. 4 E. Will. Mer. also the N.E. quarter of the S.E. quarter of said Sec'n 18, Lot 1. of said Sec 18 and Lot... of Sec 17 of said Township in King County W. T.

The Initial Point of this plat is the N.E. Cor. of block 1, which point is 5 feet South and 31 feet West of the N.E. Cor. of said Sec 18. The lots in blocks 1, 10, 11, 21, 22, 30, 36, 44, 57, 66, 67 and 77 are 60 by 120 feet. All other full lots are 60 by 114 feet, fractional lots are as shown on the plat. The portion of Wyandotte Street included in the plat is 5 feet in width; of Section St. is 36 feet wide, George St. is 53 feet wide; Henry and Oliver Str's are 60 feet wide and all other Streets are 66 feet wide.
