The petition of Robert Magne Winthurs hereby filed, respectfully sheweth:

First. My place of residence is R. F. D. No. 1, Everett Wash.
(Give number, street, city or town, and State.)

Second. My occupation is Farmer

Third. I was born on the 2 day of December, anno Domini 1884, at Gutterborg, Sweden

Fourth. I emigrated to the United States from Gutterborg, Sweden, on or about the 13 day of March, anno Domini 1894, and arrived in the United States, at the port of St. Louis, Mo., on the 20 day of Aug., anno Domini 1905, on the vessel In the interim between immigration and arrival sailed in and out of many ports

Fifth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 23 day of Jan., anno Domini 1907, at Everett Wash. in the Superior Court of Washington, Snohomish Co.

Sixth. I am married. My wife's name is Ida Josephine Winthurs She was born Butler Branch, Mich. and now resides at R. F. D. #1, Everett, Wash.

I have no children, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:

Seventh. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Gustavus V, King of Sweden of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.

Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least, immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 20 day of Aug., anno Domini 1905, and in the State of Washington, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the 20 day of Aug., anno Domini 1905, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the Superior Court of Washington, at Everett, on the 23 day of Jan., anno Domini 1907, and the said petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit, and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.)

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Commerce and Labor, together with my affidavit and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses thereto, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
