ADDITION

To the City of Seattle
Wash.

Description.

This Green Lake Home Addition to the City of Seattle, Washington, covers the following lands to wit: 1st. All that portion of land, Lot No. 1, or section 6, Twp. 25 N. R. 4 E., lying North and East of that portion of said lot conveyed by Mrs. D. Wood and wife to T. H. Robinson, by deed bearing date the 8th day of August, 1892 and recorded on Vol. 105 of the deed records of said County on page 161-160 of the Index Records of said County, on page 104, et seq., so far as Green Lake Boulevard in said deed affects the lands embraced in this plat. Number 6, No. 2, 3, 5 acres in the center line of Green Lake Boulevard on this plat being the same monuments referred to by lots designations in said deed or dedication. The inner or base line of this plat is the center line of said Green Lake Boulevard. The Streets, Alleys, Courts and Boulevards in this plat are as indicated thereon.

The inner part is the N.E. corner of lot 1 of section 6, Twp. 25 N. R. 4 E. which is also the N.E. corner of this plat.

I now Al meny by these presents: That the Green Lake Home Building and Guarantee Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Washington, and I, Wm. D. Wood, et al., bearing date the 13th day of February, 1892 and of record in Vol. 105, page 204, THE S.M. of the S.M. of the N.W. and the S.E. of said S.M. & of the N.W. of sec. 6, Twp. 25 N. R. 4 E., and 3, 5, all that part of Govt. Lot No. One (1) in said Sec. of Twp. 25 N. R. 4 E. not embraced within the recorded lots of Woodlawn Annex to Green Lake, all of said land being within the limits of the City of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington, together with all that portion of said Woodlawn Annex lying North Majority of Woodlawn Annex in said Woodlawn Annex. The inner part is the N.E. corner of lot 1 of section 6, Twp. 25 N. R. 4 E. which is also the N.E. corner of this plat.

Explanation.

I now Al meny by these presents: That the Green Lake Home Building and Guarantee Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Washington, and I, Wm. D. Wood, et al., bearing date the 13th day of February, 1892 and of record in Vol. 105 of the deed records of said King County, on page 104, et seq., with all the conditions and limitations thereon, do hereby make and declare the accompanying plat, and do dedicate to the use of the public forever, according to said plan and the description aforesaid, all the Streets, Alleys, Courts and Highways which had been by said parties heretofore dedicated, as above set forth, which dedications were contained in said deed recorded in Vol. 105 of the deed records of said King County, on page 104, et seq., with all the conditions and limitations thereon, do hereby referred to and made a part of this dedication. The foregoing dedication and dedication shall not operate to grant or allow to the public any right or use or possession outside of the boundary lines of the building, streets, alleys or highways, as platted on this plat. Wherever on any part of the area covered by this plat any residential right has heretofore been, or but for this plat would hereafter be existent or enjoyable, then notwithstanding this plat, it shall be existent and enjoyable but only according to and as limited by the boundary lines of tracts as platted upon this plat, which boundary lines shall be deemed lines of subdivision of areas possessed, used and enjoyed of all residential rights.
