A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO DIRECT \$40,000 CURRENTLY BUDGETED FOR ALLAN YORKE PARK PRIVATE SECURITY TO A CITY OF BONNEY LAKE PARK AMBASSADOR PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, In 2023 the Bonney Lake Police Department spent \$40,000 in costs for private security at Allan Yorke Park; and

WHEREAS, The Bonney Lake Police Department in collaboration with the Bonney Lake Public Services Department would develop a Park Ambassador program to replace private security at Allan Yorke Park; and


WHEREAS, the Park Ambassador program will be managed by the Public Services Department and will provide the same level of security expected from private security; and

WHEREAS, the Park Ambassador program will provide the City and residents additional customer service and Public Services coverage; and


WHEREAS, the \$40,000 to fund the Park Ambassador program will come from the existing Police Department budget; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED The Police Department is authorized to Direct \$40,000 currently budgeted for Allan Yorke Park private security to a City Of Bonney Lake Park Ambassador Program.
