**WHEREAS**, Mason County Fire Protection District Eighteen has a public service need of said equipment; and


**WHEREAS**, chapter 39.33.020 RCW, Disposal of Surplus Property, provides the authority and procedure for the disposition of this equipment; and


**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Thurston County Fire Protection District Three to divest itself of these items;




One (1) 1967 Mack pumper, VIN # C125FD1129
