WHEREAS, City officials are directed by RCW 35.77.010 to adopt a Six-Year Transportation Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, such a plan was prepared and submitted to the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on July 15th, 2025, with subsequent City Council discussion and direction.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Bonney Lake does hereby resolves as follows:

Section 1. TIP Adopted. The Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for the years 2026-2031 is adopted as a guide for the improvement of the streets of the City of Bonney Lake.

Section 2. TIP project priority number 7 moved to 2. West Tapps Highway from Bonney Lake Blvd to a new connection with Allan Yorke Park is moved from priority #7 to #2.

Section 3. Streets Ending Fund Balance is authorized to fund the design of West Tapps Hwy from Bonney Lake Blvd to a new connection with Allan Yorke Park.


