I join the President of the United States in honoring Dorothy Height, a founding matriarch of the American civil rights movement, by directing that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff **Thursday, April 29, 2010**, in her memory. She died April 20 at age 98.

Please notify your staff and all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business Thursday, or first thing Friday morning, April 30.
